Hours: By appointment, preferably 3 days ahead of appointment

Services: Private company, works with Logisticare so can transport Medicaid members, but commercially insured or private paying customers as well (cash, credit or debit card). Has app for phone to assist with scheduling rides, and if receipt needed. Must be independent getting to and from vehicle, but drivers will assist with equipment.

Rate: Vary with distance and are subject to change due to economic change and/or fuel costs.

- 0-3 Miles - \$12
- 4-6 Miles - \$15
- 7-10 Miles - \$19
- 11 (+) - \$2.00 / Mile

Services: A Neighbor must be: 1.) Over 60 years old AND unable to drive. 2.) Over 20 and have a chronic illness or physical disability. 3.) Mobile enough to get into/out of a car with minimal physical assistance from a volunteer. Client who has Medicaid will be added to the program. For any transportation not covered by Medicaid but will be referred to LogistiCare for covered medical transportation. Services must be notified 3 days before a Doctor Appointment. The application process starts with sending an email with a name and address. The application can be sent within a day. These services are not equipped with vehicles that accommodate extensive adaptive equipment.

Services: Paid by Medicaid or offers some private paid services. This service does not have equipment or wheelchair accessibility. Appointments and rides must be booked 3 days in advance.

Services: This is a service that can be downloaded through a phone app called "Uber." Rides are calculated by mileage and charged by credit/debit card of your choice. Rides can be called at any time and are fairly quick in response. Enter pick up and destination for a fair estimate.

Services: Lyft provides rides through an app. To access the system, one downloads the Lyft app and creates an account. Rides are calculated by mileage with a Fare Estimator on the app. There is no direct phone number for Lyft. They call you provided you have given them your phone number. They also offer phone support for help with any issues related to a specific Lyft ride.
